GRADE: UNDULATING

LENGTH: 10 MILES

PARKING and START: Village of Litton on Mires Lane opposite Village Shop

In a clockwise direction from Mires Lane, we walk for a short while until we pick up the Cressbrook Dale path leading us to and crossing the A623. We head to the village of Foolow and its pretty duck pond, monument and church (serving refreshments on recce walk), then on to the well known plague village of Eyam. Crossing back over the A623 there is a gradual climb through Darlton Quarry to Black Harry Lane and Blakedon Hollow passing the lake on the right before taking a path to Wardlow then back to Litton via Cressbrook Dale and Tansley Dale (another gradual climb).
