This walk uses part of The Gritstone Trail and passes through Teggs Nose Quarry from which high quality grade stone was used for everything from buildings to airfields, so much so that the Germans tried to bomb it in WW2. We pass reservoirs built in the 19th century to use water from the River Bollin in the mills of Langley and Macclesfield. Having crossed the busy A537, we walk through Vale Royal and Gulshaw Hollow before returning via another section of the Gritstone Trail.
