We start the walk from the grange country park car park. We will make our way down grange road to St. Lawrence church, crossing the road at this point and then on to marsh green and Gillow heath. We then take the lane going past the staffs knot pub, sycamore farm, and pick up part of the gritstone trail. This takes us to Nick of the hill, from this point we walk along Congleton Edge, which brings us on to the road near the Castle Inn pub. From here we go along Biddulph valley way towards Whitemoor. We leave the trail at this point, crossing over Congleton road and then we have some field walking which will bring us on to grange road and hurst road. From here we have a steady climb up to Biddulph park chapel and the Troughstones, taking the path on the east side. We then make our way back through the Grange country park, via spring wood, the boathouse, the lake path and back to the car park.
